ISLINGTON SQUARE.

Fire action at 11 Esther Anne Place, Islington Square.

If fire breaks out in your home:

- Leave the room where the fire is straight away, then close the door.
- · Tell everyone in your home and get them to leave.
- · Do not stay behind to put the fire out, or collect belongings.
- Close any doors behind you, including your flat front door, as you leave.
- Do not use any lift, use the stairs.
- · Call the fire service.
- Wait outside, away from the building.

If you see or hear of a fire in another part of the building:

- The building is designed to contain a fire in the flat where it starts. This means it is usually safe for you to stay in your own flat if the fire is elsewhere.
- Call the fire service.
- You must leave immediately if smoke or heat affects your home, or, if you are told to by the fire service.
- If you are in any doubt, get out.
- Do not use any lift, use the stairs.
- Wait outside, away from the building.

If you hear an Alarm in another part of the building whilst you are in your apartment:

- The building is designed to contain a fire in the flat/ area where it starts. This means it is
 usually safe for you to stay in your own flat if the fire is elsewhere.
- If you are in any doubt please speak to reception.

If you are in a common area when you become aware of a fire:

- Leave by the nearest available fire exit.
- Do not use any lift, use the stairs.
- Call the fire service.
- · Wait outside, away from the building.

To call the fire service:

- Dial 999 or 112 from a mobile phone.
- When the operator answers, give your telephone number and ask for FIRE.
- When the fire service reply give the address of the block as below.
- Do not end the call until the fire service has repeated the address correctly.
