If a fire breaks out in your home	Verbally raise the alarm by shouting "Fire".
	Warn all persons within your apartment and leave together.
	Where possible turn off your cooker or oven.
	Where possible close windows and doors, especially the front door .
	Do not attempt to put out the fire.
	Do not put yourself at risk.
	Leave the building by the nearest available escape route.
	Do not use the lift.
	Activate a fire alarm call point.
	Exit the building and move to a safe area outside, away from the building.
	Call the fire service by dialling 999 or 112.

	Ensure your entrance door is fully closed.
	You must leave immediately if smoke or heat affects your home, or if you are
	told to do so by the fire service.

	Do not end the call until the fire service has repeated the address correctly.
